Dear Doctor:

I am planning a second part of **“IT’S ALL IN YOUR HEAD SEMINAR”**, which will be presented at the Parsippany Sheraton Hotel, by Paul T. Sprieser, D.C., DIBAK, on October 24 & 25, 2009. This seminar will be all cranial techniques and cover all areas of approach for treating this problem.

Knowledge about cranial faults and their corrections should be considered critically essential to every chiropractor whether their practice is considered subluxation based (straight) or mixers. All chiropractors correct subluxation regardless of their method of adjusting, but rarely will this correct a cranial fault. Since chiropractor might consider themselves as doctors of the nervous system, why not treat the entire structure of this system. If we are considering the nervous system and its structural protection it must include the vertebral column including the sacrum and pelvis and the skull or cranium. Why only treat 50% of this system when you can treat the whole system?

Who of our patients have cranial faults? The answer simply is everyone especially if you don’t know how to diagnose and treat this problem. The causative factors for the cranial faults while, predictable constant vary from patient to patient. These factors can be trauma such as blows to the skull, whiplash injuries from car accidents or falls, poor dental occlusion or even orthodontic work, pronation of the feet and even mental or emotional trauma that cause muscular tension changes to the skull.

So it should be evident why every chiropractor should know how to diagnose and treat cranial faults and this seminar will give the most comprehensive and easy to apply system for treating this problem.
